 - c. Mr. Achyut Aradhye suggested to introduce the course IT Service Management which will help the students to understand how to deploy the code, service management, support, chain management and to give better understanding of the IT industry. Also suggested to think CC course from operation model. Mr. Subhash Tatale suggested to add these contents Agile & Devops course. Mr Eshwar suggested people are not keen on L1 & L2 engineering job. Inforamation security is the need of the hour and should be added in all the offered courses.
 - d. Dr . Laxmi Bewoor suggested course on Industry 5.0 and covering the required industry contsents in that.


