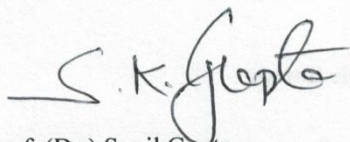

Dear madam,

I had a meeting with the faculty going to Walawalkar Hospital on 25th November 2018. Our strategy will be as follows:

- 1) Prof (Mrs) Habbu will discuss the non-invasive Glucometer she has developed over the past 2 years. She will like to collaborate with Walawalkar Hospital to get data from persons of different age groups, ailments, etc on her instrument and compare it with that obtained by standard pathological test. If she gets enough data over a period of 1 year she can standardize her method till POC. After this study she can take the next step of incubation for which she can get funding from appropriate government agency.
- 2) Prof (Mrs) Ratnaparkhi has developed a compact and portable 12-lead ECG. She also would like to validate it with standard instrument on a large cross section of population to do POC. Incubation will be the next step.
- 3) Prof (Mrs) Minal Deshmukh has developed a RF ID based Health card which is very useful in accident patients or rural patients who cannot give their medical history and/ or personal information, etc. She would like to take this forward in a rural hospital like Walawalkar Hospital.
- 4) Prof S S Joshi will be heading the Bio-medical engineering vertical in the future and hence is interested in exploring the possibilities in establishing a vertical with strong collaborative partner like Walawalkar Hospital.


Apart from these personal field of interestes we would also be discussing the possibilities with Dr Jha, who is conducting the workshop, of funding sources and collaborative ideas.

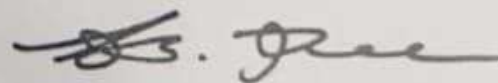

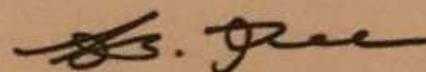
