The normal haemoglobin level in any average men body should be from 13.5 to 17.5 grams per deciliter and in every average women body should be 12.0 to 15.5 grams per decilitre. But from many studies and surveys, it is observed that the haemoglobin level in many young girls is less than normal level than boys due to which many willing girls are not able to donate blood.

Blood Donation Report

Venue: - VIIT, Pune.

Date: - 27th September, 2018

A blood donation camp was organized by NSS committee of Vishwakarma Institute of Information Technology in association with Jankalyan Blood Bank and Acharya Anandrishiji Blood Bank on 27th September, 2018. The event incharge was Siddhant Kolkar. The meeting was taken by the event heads and the work was distributed among the committee members. They were divided in different committees like food, registration, discipline, publicity etc. The college supported the blood donation event by giving the permission to use the staff parking area and all required amenities like tables, chairs, etc. Necessary arrangements for the event like cleaning up the place, setting up tables and chairs for registration, refreshments, etc. were done one day before the event. The promotion for the camp was done by the publicity committee by putting up posters inside and outside the college campus, sending messages to the students and visiting the classrooms in and other colleges such as V.I.M., V.C.A.C.S., V.U. A street Percussion performed by the NSS team in college campus for the publicity of Blood Donation. The publicity was done few days before the event and also on the day of the event in order to inform everyone about the blood donation camp. On the day of event the committee members were present in the college by 06:00 A.M. The remaining arrangements and Rangoli were made on the day of event.

The ambulances of both blood banks arrived at around 08:30 A.M. and they set up their booths. Two booths, one for each blood bank was set up at the given place. The blood donation camp started at around 09:00 A.M. The entries of donors were taken on college server. It will help VIIT college students to access their information through college LAN. Dr. R.S.Acharya (Dean of student affairs) and Nitin Sakhre Sir (NSS programme officer) and Prof. Priya Belekar were also present for the event. After 09:00 A.M.the students and faculty started arriving to donate blood. The staff (technical and non-technical) of all departments actively participated for this noble cause. Their names were noted down at the registration desk and they were given forms by the blood banks where they had to fill all the required details. The donors got their haemoglobin and blood pressure checked in the booth before donating blood. It was observed that most of the females could not donate blood because they were either underweight or their haemoglobin level was below normal. The necessary information of the donors was noted on server website systematically. After blood donation the donors were provided biscuits, idli, bananas, tea. A certificate of appreciation by the blood banks was given to all the donors. This year, the total count of donors was 420 i.e., number of donors proved that the message spread by the volunteers was well received by all and hence the event was successful. NSS-VIIT plans to continue their work of social welfare in the same way in the coming days.

The Event ended at 06:30P.M. Prof. Priya Belhekar appreciated the committee members for their efforts and praised them for their work. The Ex-NSS committee members appreciated the efforts taken by awarding volunteers with certificates. In this way, NSS-VIIT conducted another event for the betterment of the society.

Promotion of Swachhata-MoHUA App

NSS had successfully conducted a Promotional Campaign of the "Swacchata-MoHUA App" on 5th October, 2018 in college and nearby areas. Swacchata-MoHUA is the official app of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs of Government of India. The app enables a citizen to post a civic-related issue (eg; garbage dump) which is then forwarded to the city corporation concerned and thereafter assigned to the sanitary inspector of the particular ward.

The app has been built by IChangeMyCity – a division of Janaagraha, a Bengaluru based non-profit working to improve the quality of life in India's cities and towns.

How does it work?

Take a picture of the Civic-related issue using your smart phone, and post it in one of the following categories.

- · Garbage dump
- · Garbage vehicle not arrived
- Dustbins not cleaned
- Sweeping not done
- Dead animals
- Public toilet(s) cleaning
- Public toilet(s) blockage
- No water supply in public toilet(s)
- No electricity in public toilet(s)

The app will capture the location while the picture is being taken. Just type in the landmark of the complaint location. The complaint will then be assigned to the concerned sanitary inspector/engineer. You can also vote up on any other complaint relevant to you. You will get regular updates on status of the complaint in the form of a push notification with

the 'Resolved' image uploaded by the assigned sanitary inspector/engineer. You can also reopen the complaint if you are not satisfied with the resolution of the complaint.

NSS volunteers split themselves into teams and campaigned in the college and surrounding area. Volunteers helped people to install this app and to register themselves. They also helped them to learn different features of the app.

Many local residents and staff members appreciated the efforts taken by the volunteers.

Residential Camp

Date: - 23rd December, 2018 to 30th December, 2018

The NSS residential camp was conducted successfully in Jamgaon village from 23rd December, 2018 to 30th December, 2018. In the duration of 8-days and 7-nights, different sacraments were done on volunteers.

For that, various activities were conducted, guest lectures were arranged, plays and games were arranged, etc. The meaning and importance of principles like dedication, determination, devotion, discipline, morality, selflessness, unity was also thought to them.

For the publicity of the camp 2 methods were used which are face-to-face publicity and the other is social media publicity. The publicity team started their work for face to face publicity from 19th November, 2018 and social media publicity were started from 9th November, 2018 in which we had uploaded a promotional video of the residential camp on youtube and many posters were spreaded on Instagram and other social platforms. We had also hanged a flex on our college building for the publicity purpose so that maximum number of people would know about the camp. The registrations for NSS residential camp were held from 20th November, 2018 to 22nd November, 2018 and we get registrations of 250 volunteers because of limit of 250 volunteers many students were unable to register. For the registrations our strategy was to go paperless and to achieve this we had done all the registration using google forms and for the confirmation of the registration, confirmation e-mails including pdf file of all filled data were sent to registrants. This process saved the time as well as the paper waste. In the period of 3 days, we had achieved the target of 250 registrations which is a landmark in our college history as no other activity of our college had got 250 registrations in such a less time because of which the committee members were very happy and thrive to work hard to make our residential camp best of best.

The stay for the volunteers was planned in the local Zilha Parishad School for boys and for girls 2 houses were arranged which were under 100m distance from the school. For doing arrangements for the volunteer's committee members reached Jamgaon on 22nd December, 2018 and started their work. To complete all the work effectively and in-time, it was distributed in parts between all the committee members and for that different domains were made like water, food, logistics, tree plantation, shramdan, discipline, accommodation, transportation, etc. The school and houses were cleaned and bulbs were fitted in dark areas also wire fitting was checked to avoid accidents. Senior committee members guided us to overcome all the obstacles.

Day 1

On 23rd December, 2018 which was the arrival date for volunteers, committee members started their work from sharp 4 AM. The volunteers were instructed to gather in the college in the allotted time slot. College bus and car were arranged for the transportation. On arrival of the volunteers, breakfast was distributed and they were allowed to rest. A "Rapid answer without yes or no type words" game was conducted by the cultural team after the breakfast of the volunteers. All the volunteers were distributed in 10 groups named as Takshashila, Magadh, Kalinga, Maurya, Ayodhya, Vijaynagar, Pataliputra, Prayag, Indraprastha, Chalukya. As an advisor 1 committee member is allotted to every group. After some time, all the necessary instructions are given to the volunteers. An opening ceremony was arranged in the camp premises in which Prof. Dr. B. S. Karkare (The Director, VIIT, Pune) and from Jamgaon, Rambhau Thombre were present as a chief guest. The dinner was served to volunteers after taking some fun activities so that volunteers get to know each other.

Tea was served to volunteers at 05:05 am - 05:25 am. After tea volunteers were taken to running for 6 km daily from 05:25 am to 06:30 am. Yoga period was taken from 06:30 am -07:30 am. After yoga all the volunteers were taken to shramdan from 07:30 am - 09:30 am. Breakfast were served to all the volunteers from 09:30 am - 10:15 am. After breakfast from 10:15 am - 12:30 pm, a game or cultural activity were taken for the entertainment of the volunteers. From 12:30 pm - 02:00 pm, lunch was served to the volunteers and the committee members. After lunch volunteers were allowed to rest upto 03:45 pm. Guest Lectures were arranged for volunteers from 04:00 pm – 05:00 pm. After guest lecture all the volunteers were sent to allotted houses for teaching local students, the time allotted for educational activity was from 05:00 pm - 07:00 pm. Blood Donation Camp

A blood donation camp was organized by NSS committee of Vishwakarma Institute of Information Technology in association with Jankalyan Blood Bank and Acharya Anandrishiji Blood Bank on 27th February, 2018. The event was done by second year NSS Volunteers. The event incharge was Siddhant Kolkar (The President, NSS VIIT). The meeting was taken by the event heads and the work was distributed among the Volunteers. They were divided in to different committees like documentation, food, registration, discipline, publicity etc. The college supported the blood donation event by giving the permission to use the staff parking area and all required amenities like tables, chairs, etc. Necessary arrangements for the event like cleaning up the place, setting up tables and chairs for registration, refreshments, etc. were done one day before the event. The promotion for the camp was done by the publicity committee by putting up posters inside and outside the college campus, sending messages to the students and visiting the classrooms in and other colleges such as V.C.A.C.S., V.U. A street play and bullet rally was done by the NSS team in college campus for the publicity of Blood Donation. The publicity was done few days before the event and also on the day of the event in order to inform everyone about the blood donation camp. On the day of event the committee members were present in the college by 06:30 A.M. The remaining arrangements and Rangoli were made on the day of event.

The ambulances of both blood banks arrived at around 08:30 A.M. and they set up their booths. Two booths, one for each blood bank was set up at the given place. The blood donation camp started at around 09:00 A.M. The entries of donors were taken on app (NSS VIIT) developed by the documentation team. Dr. R.S.Acharya (Dean of student affairs) and Nitin Sakhre Sir (NSS programme officer) and Prof. Priya Belhekar (NSS programme officer) were also present for the event. After 09:00 A.M the students and faculty started arriving to donate blood.



The staff (teaching and non-teaching) of all departments actively participated for this noble cause. Their names were noted down at the registration desk and they were given forms by the blood banks where they had to fill all the required details. The donors got their haemoglobin and blood pressure checked in the booth before donating blood. It was observed that most of the females could not donate blood because they were either underweight or their haemoglobin level was below normal. The necessary information of the donors was noted on app (NSS VIIT) systematically. After blood donation the donors were provided biscuits, idli, bananas, tea. A certificate of appreciation by the blood banks was given to all the donors. This year, the total count of donors was 385 i.e., number of donors proved that the message spread by the volunteers was well received by all and hence the event was successful. NSS-VIIT plans to continue their work of social welfare in the same way in the coming days.

The Event ended at 06:30P.M. Prof. Priya Belhekar appreciated the committee members for their efforts and praised them for their work. The Ex-NSS committee members appreciated the efforts taken by awarding volunteers with certificates. In this way, NSS-VIIT conducted another event for the betterment of the society.
