

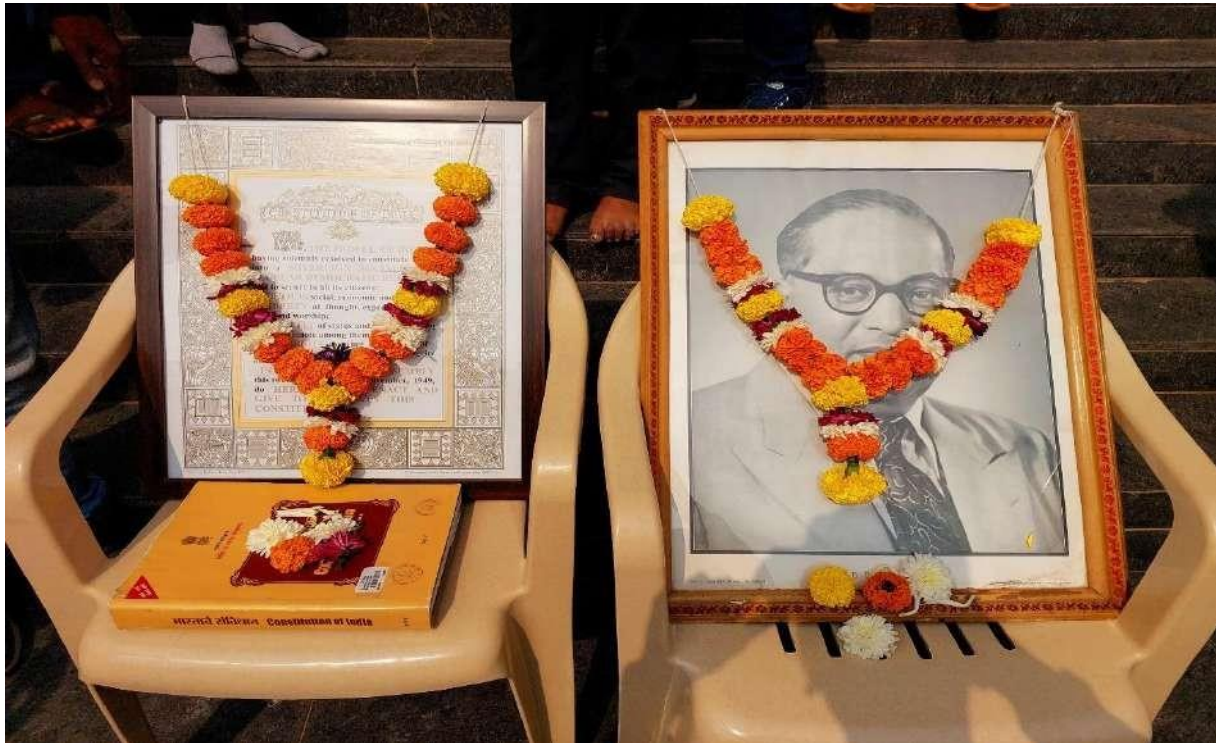

About the event:



Volunteers Making Posters



NSS CAMP Day 4

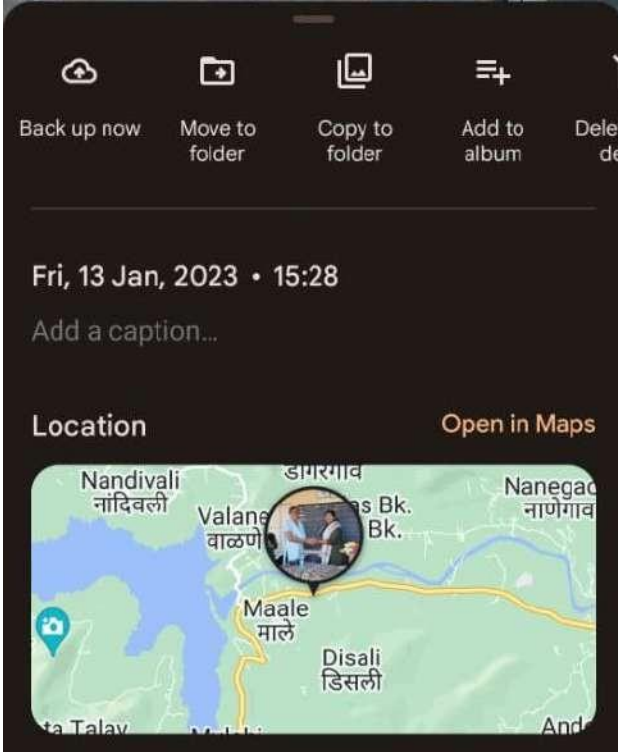
Date: 13th January 2023




Kentan sir guiding students & Volunteers giving feedback

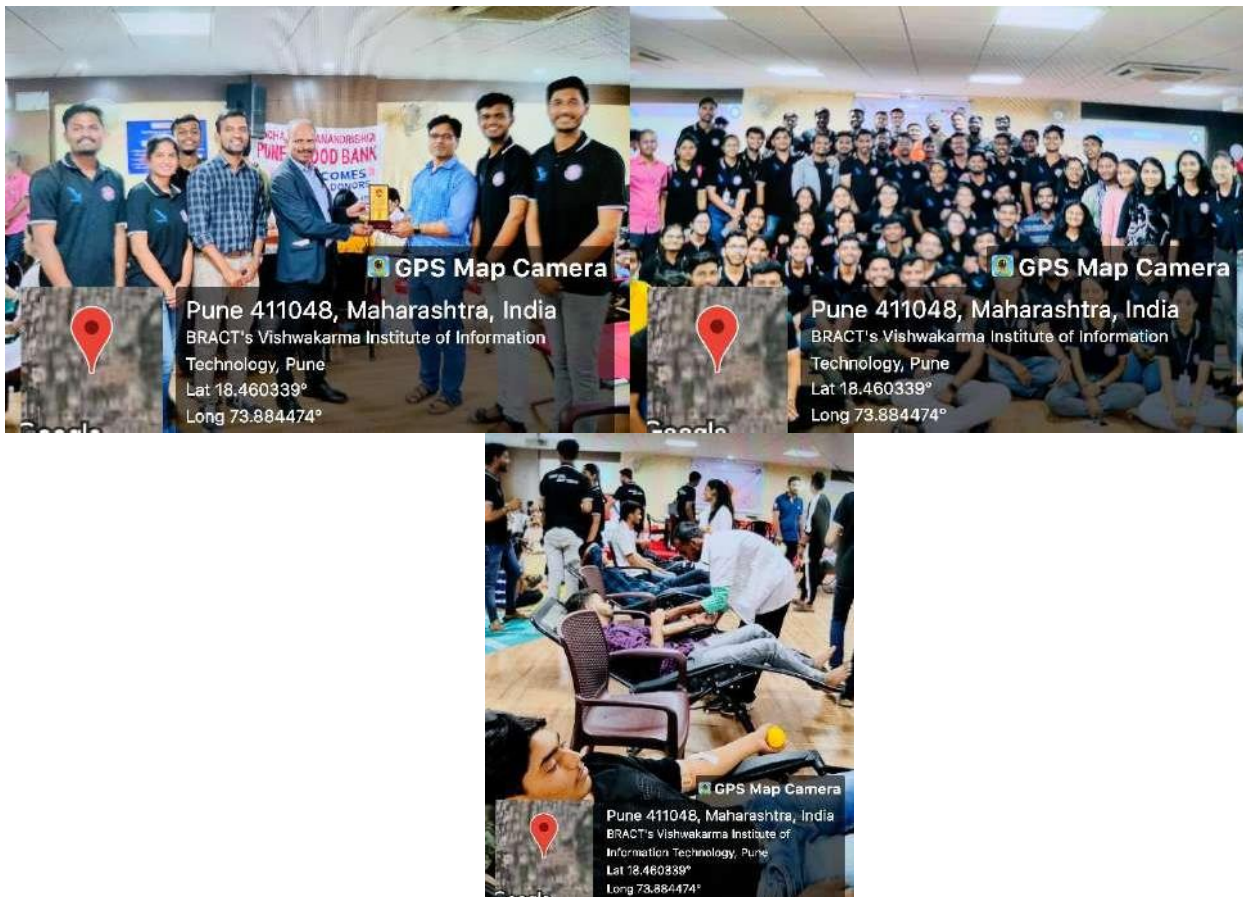
