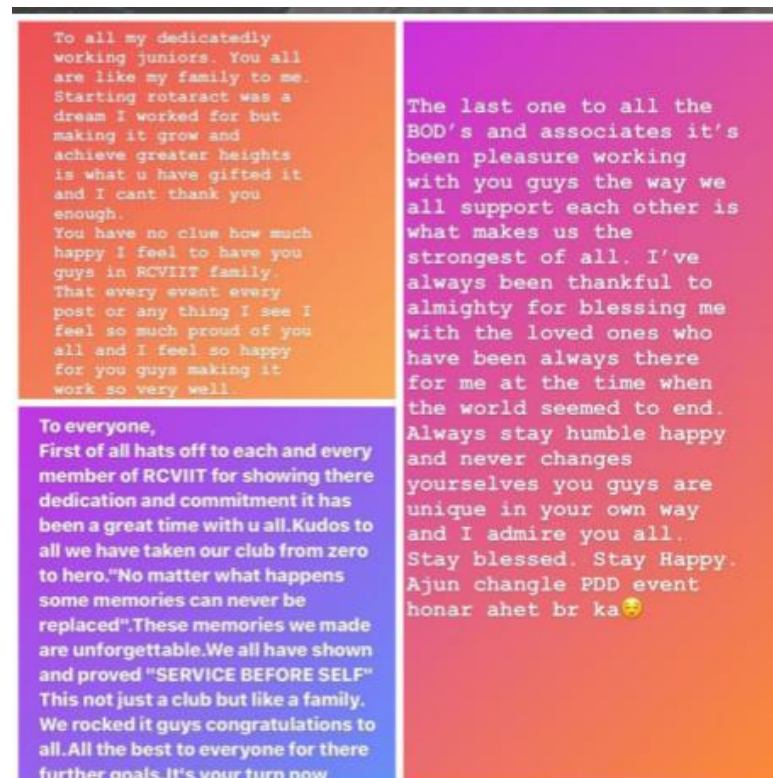
Ø **Venue:-** Online event

An Online Dance competition to encourage young minds to take up dancing as a hobby during the lockdown phase.

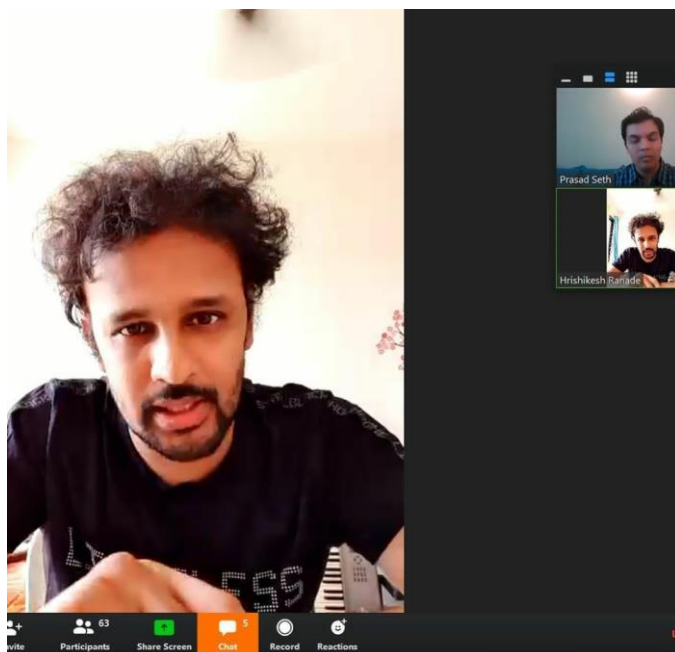
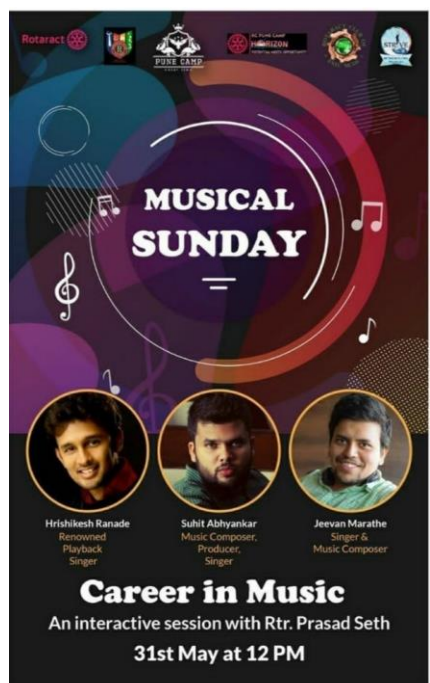
24. Jitni Pyass Utna Glass
